

Henrik Ibsen (1828-1906) was a great 19th century Norwegian playwright who was considered one of the first prominent figures of modern theatre. Ibsen wrote many famous plays but none more so than A Doll's House, which was controversial in its time for its criticism of 19th century marriages and morals yet remains the world's most performed play today.
