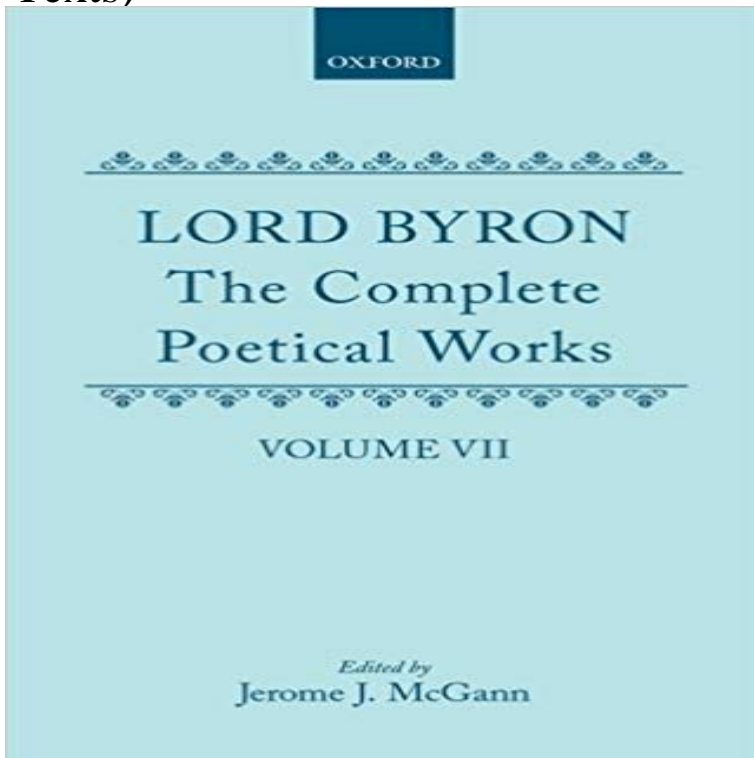


# The Complete Poetical Works: Volume VII ( c OET t Oxford English Texts)
