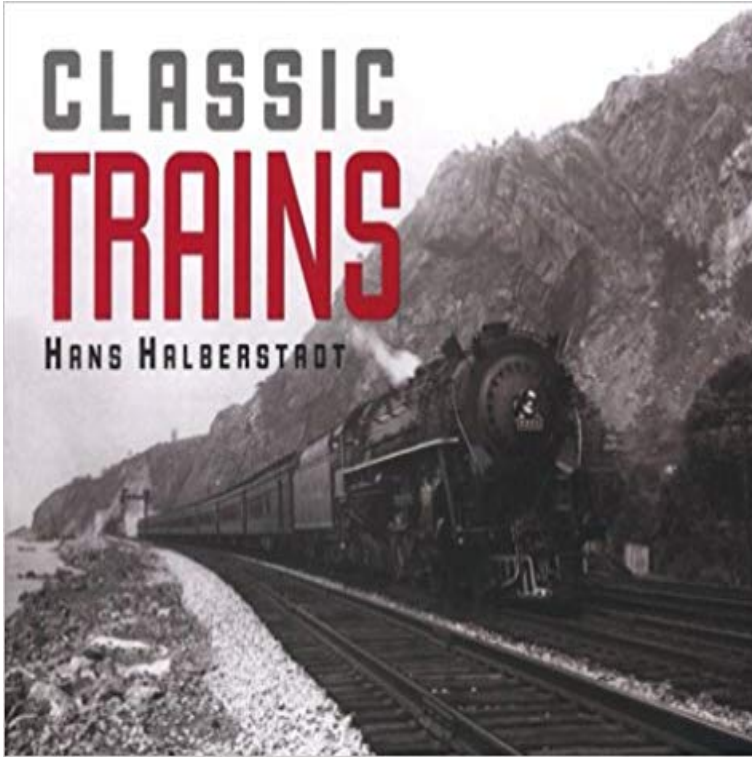


Classic Trains
