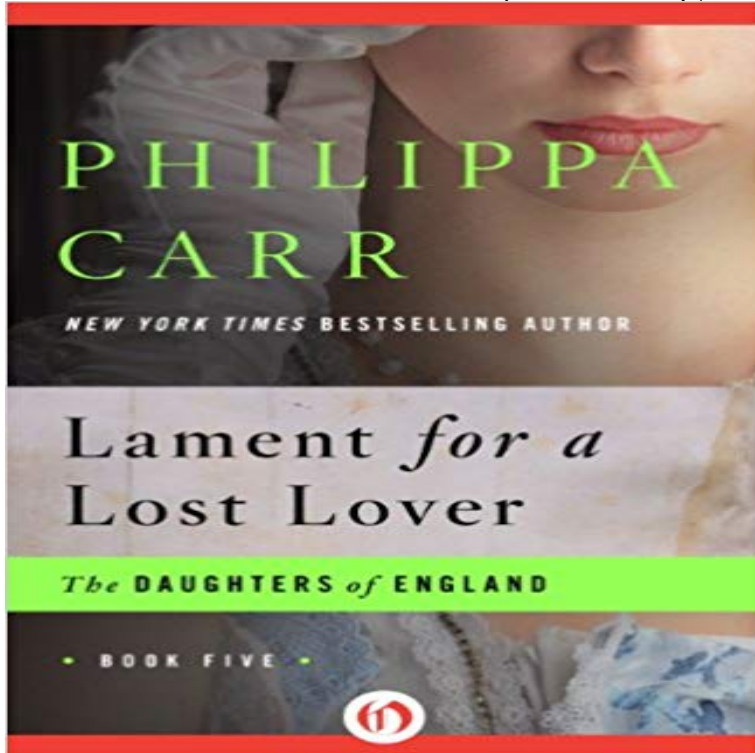


Lament for a Lost Lover (The Daughters of England Book 5)
