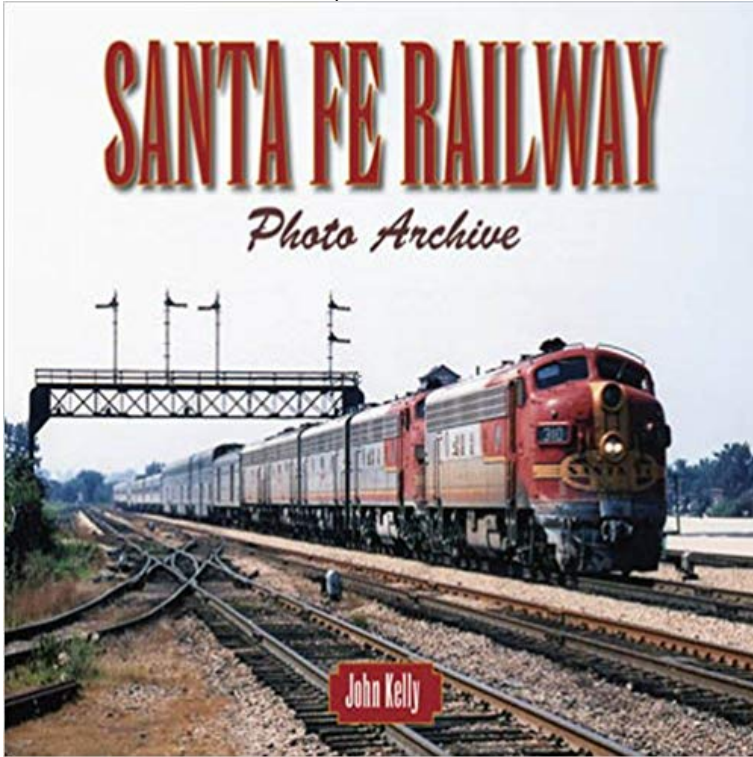


Santa Fe Railway Photo Archive
