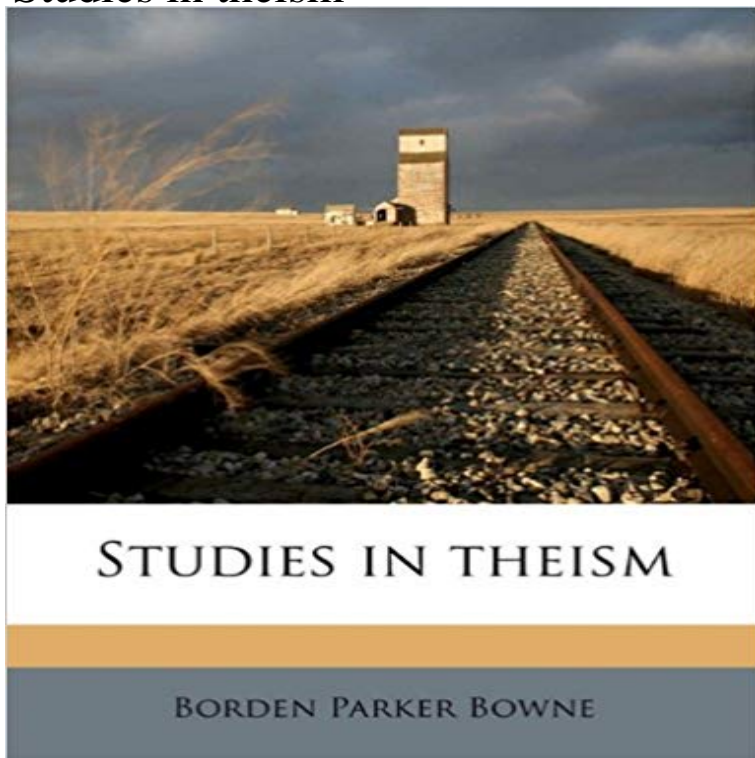


Studies in theism
