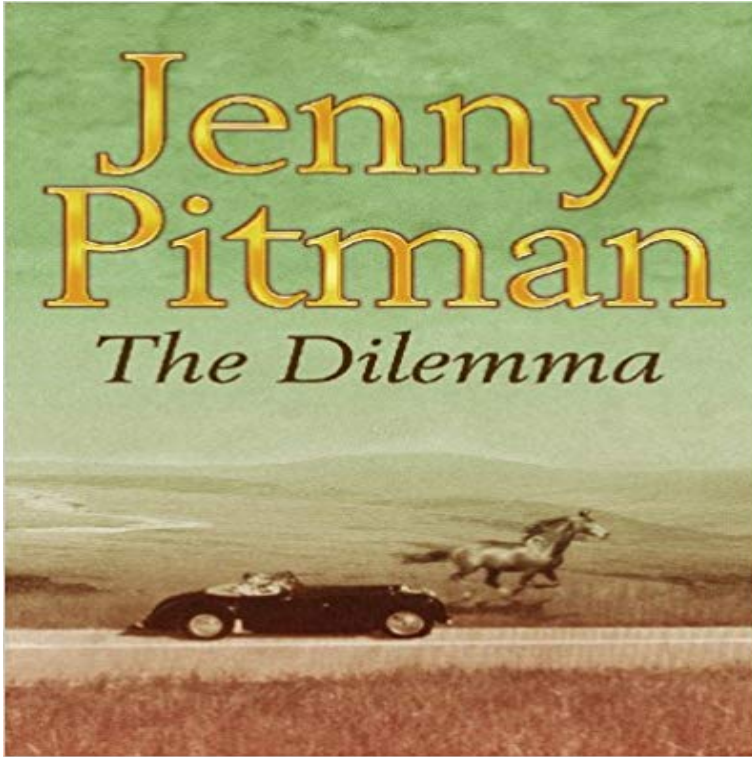


The Dilemma
