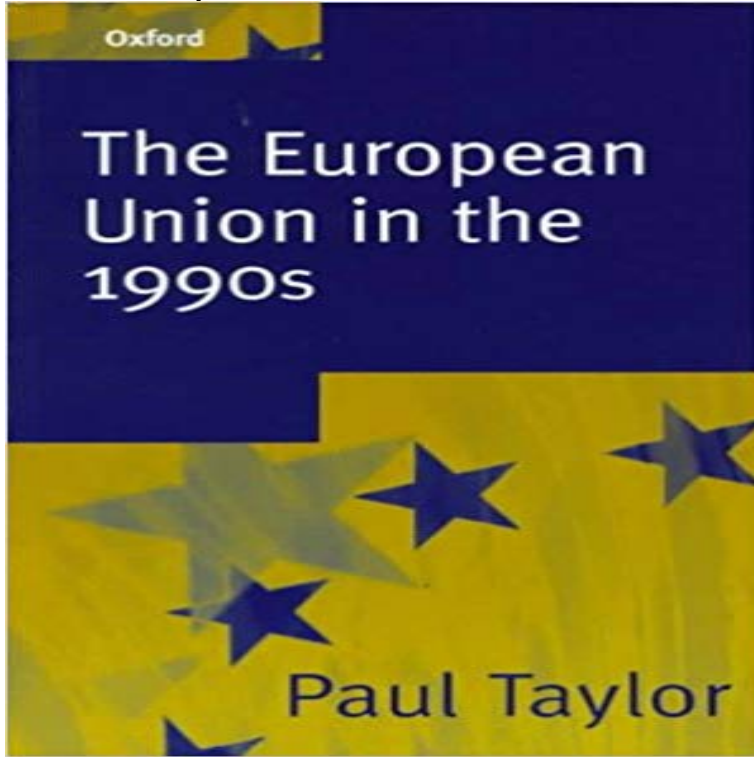


# The European Union in the 1990s
