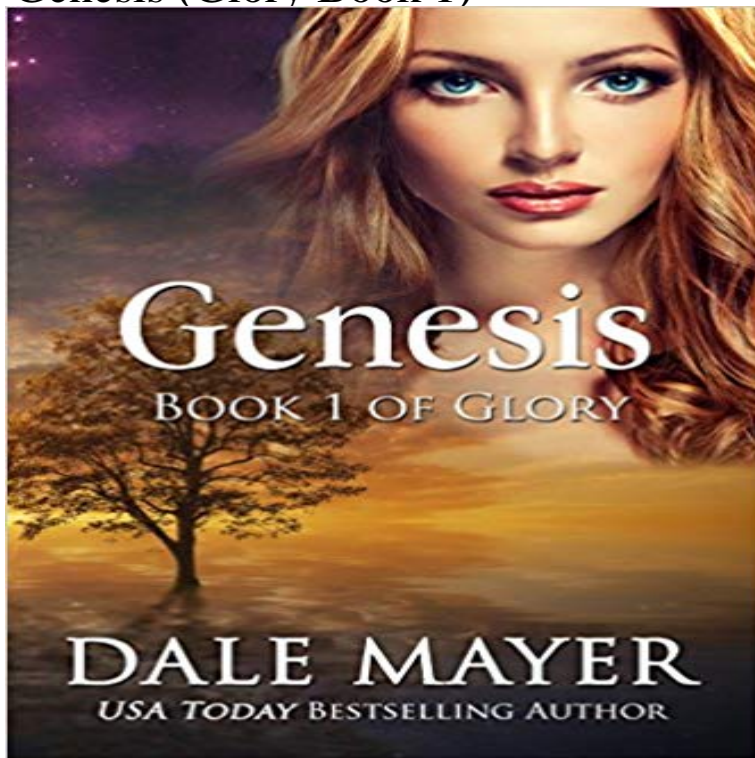


## Genesis (Glory Book 1)
