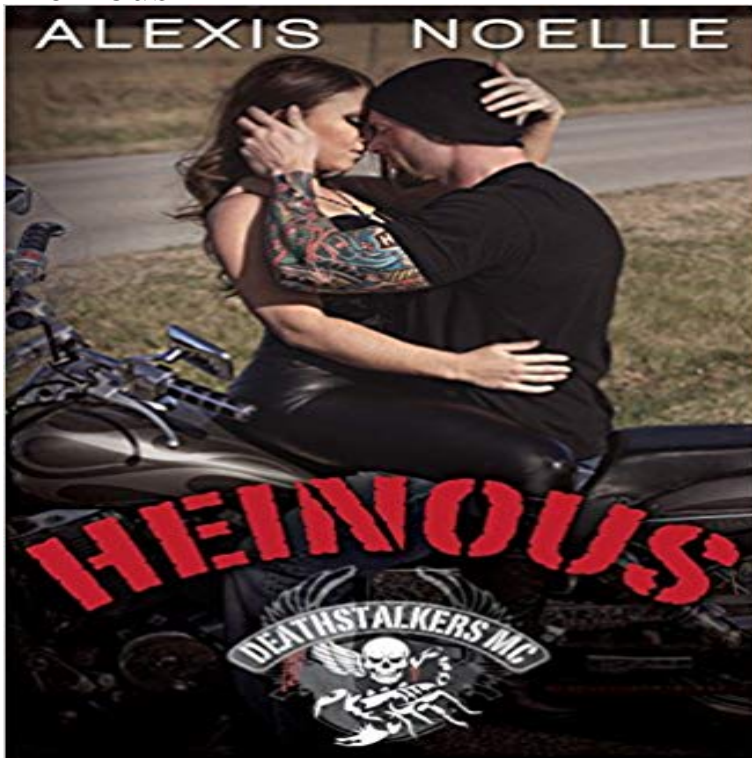


# Heinous
